SEX: Male

On 11-28-11, at about 7:40 PM, Witness One (W1) enters the apartment complex laundry room (600 block of Prospect Avenue, South Pasadena, CA). As W1 enters, Suspect One (S1) exits laundry room and W1 does not recognize S1 as a tenant in the complex. Once W1 enters the laundry room, W1 sees coin boxes to washer/dryer pried opened. W1 attempts to chase after S1, but loses sight of S1.

Witness Two is standing in front of the apartment complex and sees S1 walk to the front and meets Suspect Two. Both suspects then got on bicycles and rode southbound on Prospect Avenue.

The apartment complex laundry room had been recently burglarized twice. Both prior incidents, the washer/dryer coin boxes were pried opened, loss had been coins. There have been other similar burglaries to apartment unit laundry room washer/dryers in the city in the past two weeks.
