STOLEN VEHICLE

RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

- 2-3-12, 4:50 PM to 10:15 PM, 1300 block of Oak. Suspect(s) smashes rear door window and reach in to unlock door to gain entry. **LOSS:** Laptop computer and backpack.
- 2-1-12, 3 PM to 5 PM, 1900 block of Monterey. Suspect(s) forces front door open to gain entry. **LOSS:** Jewelry.

MINOR IN POSSESSION OF TOBACCO

2-7-12, 3:36 PM, 1100 block of Oxley. Officer sees suspect who is a known juvenile smoking a cigarette. Suspect is contacted and also has tobacco paraphernalia in possession. **SUSPECT ARRESTED:** *Male, Juvenile.*

DRUNK IN PUBLIC

2-1-12, 2:46 PM, 800 block of Fair Oaks (Fair Oaks Cigar). Suspect enters store and falls asleep. Suspect is intoxicated and employees attempt to wake up suspect. Suspect refuses to leave and police are called. Officers arrive and escort suspect outside of store. Suspect is intoxicated and unable to care for himself. **SUSPECT ARRESTED:** *Male, Black, 38 years, Burbank.*
